I appreciate your interest in requesting the enclosed application for our Fall 2010 Kindergarten class. All children who apply for kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 1, 2010.

Completed forms must be received no later than Monday, January 11, 2010, but I encourage you to return your materials as quickly as possible.

Each applicant will be asked to come for a group evaluation in the Kindergarten classroom at 234 Ulloa Street (the former Convent) on Saturday, January 30, 2010. **Please reserve this day.**

Individual child evaluations will be held on January 19th, 20th, 21st, 25th, 26th, and 27th.

While your child is being individually evaluated for kindergarten readiness on one of these days, you will be meeting with Father Dan Nascimento, our pastor, and me. St. Brendan is a vibrant school and parish community, and we want to make you feel welcomed. Again, these meetings will be held at 234 Ulloa Street.

The form is included on which you can request particular dates and times for this individual family meeting, which should take no longer than 30 minutes. **Please give me as many choices as you can.** You will receive exact dates and times for both group and individual evaluations after January 13, 2010. Remember the sooner you submit your forms, the more likely it is you will receive your first choice of date and time.

Although we would love to be able to accept every child who applies to St. Brendan School, that is not always possible. We give priority to families with children already in the school; then to Catholic families who have been registered, contributing members of our parish for more than a year; then to other Catholic families. We are happy to accept non-Catholic families if space permits.
